We bring 6 to 8 AA meetings in Spanish and English monthly to the Tulare County Jail. Our volunteers attend the AA meetings being held at Avenal, Corcoran, and SATF Prisons as often as possible. AA literature is provided upon request at our meetings.

We have streamlined our H&I communications by using a texting service. So far it is working out nicely. At our next business meeting on July 11, we will discuss how the text service is working out.
