The August YTD Financial report has not changed much since June and is as follows:

August ended at a negative \$1,411.88 and a positive balance of \$773.75 year to date. This leaves us in a Neutral financial position. Currently, we remain approximately \$25,000.00 under our recommended 6 month prior year expenses cash on hand. To date, our income is 2.1% less than last year while our total expense is 2.5% higher accounting for this continued dip into our cash reserves. Group treasurers are encouraged to send Pink Can monies to H&I on a regular basis; this is helpful for accounting and more realistic income reporting.

As there seems to be some question regarding how we calculate our recommended cash on hand, I provide this explanation: Our committee uses our past year expenses to get our monthly average then times that number by 6. For 2024 the monthly average was \$53,564.60 per month. I have added a section showing this on our financial report hoping that this will make it easier to share with our fellowship.

Please continue to share our financial position with your local fellowship. It is important that accurate financial information is shared. If you are aware of a group that is not passing the pink can, please encourage them to do so.
