For the period from Nov 21st, 2025 thru Dec 20th, 2025 Central Office had an income of \$3,928.69 and expenses of \$3,638.25 for a **gain of \$290.44** for this accounting period, we're ahead by \$2,424.13 for the year.

This office is totally self-supported through your contributions so thank you for all you do!

The price will be \$0.58 per pamphlet except P-22 & P-33 which will be \$1.08 each.
