

I have discovered a potential problem with The Events Calendar plugin. It appears to be leaving entries in a database that were supposed to be temporary only. The symptoms are that when someone goes to click on an event, the throbber simply sits and spins. I

may have to open a support ticket with The Events Calendar company.

I added three contact forms and an anti-spam program “hCaptcha” to our website. The contact forms are for P.I., C.P.C., and our main Contact Us page. Here is a sample from the P.I. page:
